The ALGWA NSW Executive has passed resolutions to promote the Local Government Women in Sport Equity Program that will run along the same lines to the 50:50 Vision Councils for Gender Equity Program. The resolutions are:

1. That ALGWA NSW joins Local Government NSW in calling all Councils to promote women in sport by improved access, participation and equity for all women and girls.
2. That ALGWA NSW members seek endorsement of this motion at their own Councils

That Council undertakes to promote women in sport by improved access, participation and equity for women and girls; participates in the Local Government Women in Sport Equity Program, and endorses membership of Womensport and Recreation NSW.

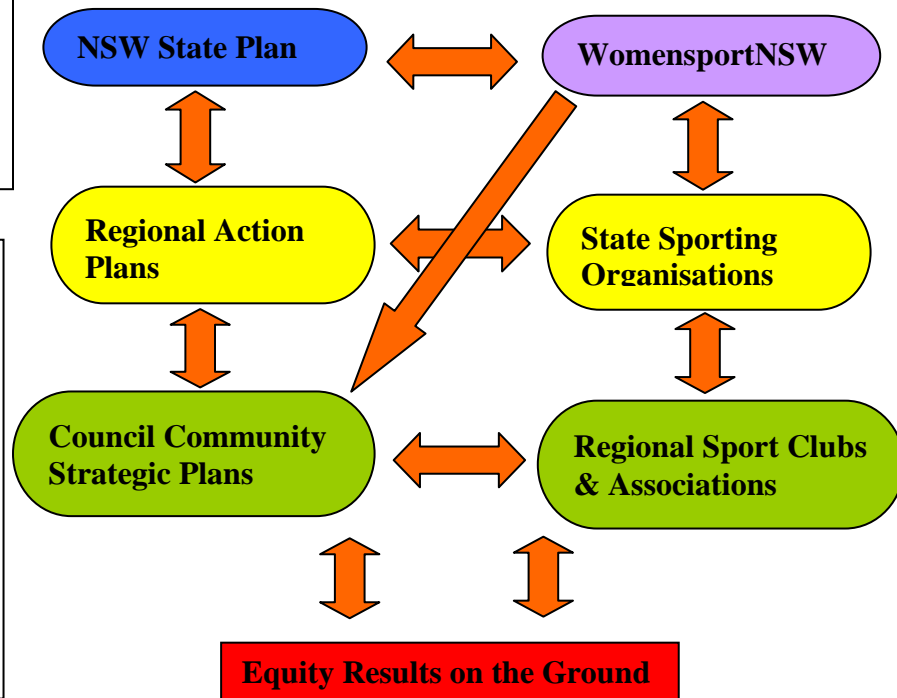
